Aims and Scope

The Journal of the JSTP provides the most advanced scientific and technical information on the technology of plasticity in Japan as well as promotes the international exchange of technical research. The Journal covers all aspects of modern forming technology such as sheet forming, bulk forming, powder forming and polymer forming. Articles concerning the boundary areas of the plastic forming industry are strongly encouraged.

1. Authors

The first author of the paper must be a member of the JSTP.

2. Originality

Papers submitted must be original and previously unpublished.

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The language of the Journal is English and the units used are SI. The maximum space available is six printed pages (allowable charged-excess: +4 pages) for a regular paper, six printed pages (allowable charged-excess: +4 pages) for a review paper, three printed pages for a note and 1/3 page for a letter including figures and tables.

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Sample Layout for a regular paper:

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The text should be arranged in the following manner: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Discussions, Results, Acknowledgements, References, Nomenclature, Appendix.

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Use short paragraphs wherever possible. Express ideas clearly and avoid using jargon. Abbreviations should be explained in the text. If many abbreviations are used, a table of abbreviations should be included.
